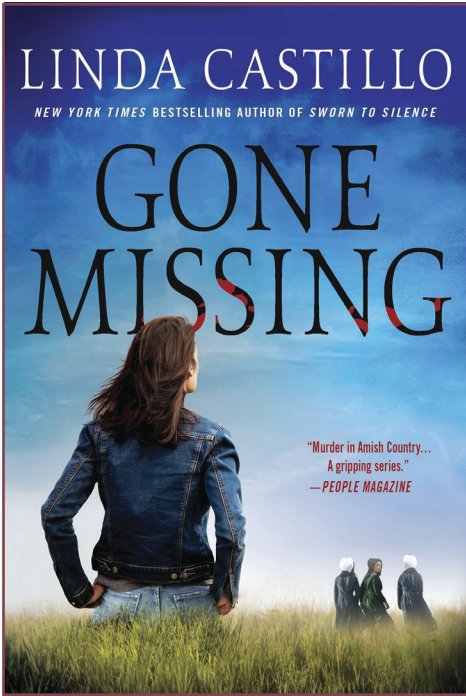
The Central Mississippi Regional Library System (CMRLS) recently announced that all of their libraries now have wireless printing - including Pelahatchie Public Library.

Gone Missing cover

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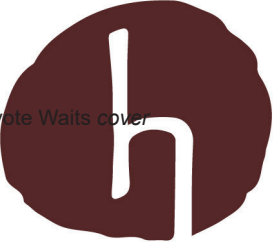


Shamburger is Overall Rankin Chamber Teacher of the Year
